#### SUMMARY FOR TASK FORCE MEETING - 1986

Renal dietitians from Network II met February 20 and 21 in Portland, Oregon, for the annual Task Force meeting. Adjectives such as excellent, worthwhile, informative, and money well spent, were used by the attendees to describe the two day conference.

Jan Weber, Management Consultant, helped individuals understand the relationship of time to other resources they manage, the concept of delegation and establishing priorities. She suggested practical ways of improving time management so items of priority are accomplished and free/personal time is still available, including ideas to save time on meetings and conferences, reducing paperwork, reducing visitor interruptions, saving on telephone time, and hot tips on office management.

Dr. Richard Parker, Nephrologist, presented an overview of deterioration of kidney function as it leads to failure and dialysis, and the relation of protein in the diet to kidney function.

Katy Wilkens, R.D., presented information and conducted a "hands-on" practice session on use of anthropometrics. Katy provided current procedures and protocols, tables, and formulas for use of anthropometrics with renal patients. Katy led discussion on topics including the pros and cons of use of anthropometrics, proper technique in measurement, and factors affecting accurate and consistent measurement.

The Sharing Session provided an opportunity for Network II renal dietitians to share their ideas, projects, and expertise. Some of the topics included: Low Protein Diets and Aminess, Nutrition Support: Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition, Dietitian Staffing Ratio, and Vitamin Supplementation in the Renal Patient.
